All residents must follow the policy of 2 cars per unit. No trailers, boats, or camper type vehicles are permitted on the regime property. All vehicles must be in good repair and properly registered in the state. Out of state tags should be converted to South Carolina within 30 days. Call BMV for further information on this matter.

Residents must respect other owners and tenants in regards to guests using other parking places.

Each unit has 2 (two) places. There are no extra spaces. Residents must contact other residents for permission to use one of their spaces. If guests are on the property longer than 24 hours, you must get a Vehicle Parking Permit which must be displayed in the guest vehicle. Vehicles not registered with the office are subject to towing.

Parking between building 1 and 2 are to be standard size cars, SUVs and small pickup trucks.
